 - Registered for exams by July 31st
 - Licensed by September 30th
- Apply through PhORCAS
- Deadline to apply is January 5th

PGY1 pharmacy residency programs build on Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) education and outcomes to contribute to the development of clinical pharmacists responsible for medication-related care of patients with a wide range of conditions, eligible for board certification, and eligible for postgraduate year two (PGY2) pharmacy residency training.
